

Arty Summer Camp is here again, our **5**th year! It is always a fun-filled and creative week. We go on local morning trips to do research, draw, paint and play games and then head back to the studio to do ceramics and other creative activities, all based on our wonderful city. The children will be tutored in **English** and will be encouraged to use English as much as possible.









Who? Small groups of non-native and native children (maximum 8*)

When? 28th June – 2nd July 2021 (6-9 year olds) 5-9th July (10 –13 year olds) 12-16th July (10 –13 year olds)

Where? Studio 56, c/Burgos & short local excursions

What will we do?

We will spend time **exploring** an artist or topic for each project and this will involve a short **excursion** to a park, building, museum (if possible) or sculpture. They will be encouraged to **draw** and take photos during the excursion. We will then head back to the studio to **create** our own pieces of art. There will be a morning and lunchtime break, and also down time for reading and journal work.

What Health & Safety measures are taken?

- Government COVID-19 health & safety measures in place at the time will be followed. In order to prepare for these measures parents would need to provide their children with:
 - their own pens and pencils, coloured pens and other stationary of their choice (paints, brushes, scissors and other materials will be provided)
 - o their own overall ('bata') or t-shirt
 - water bottles
 - o mask (if required at the time)
 - o mid morning snack (fruit or biscuits) & lunch (salad, sandwiches etc)
- Games, snack times and lunch will take place outside of the studio
- *Under the current guidelines each child requires 4sqm within an enclosed space and this will be considered. Each child will have their own desk, each child being 2m apart
- *Excursions will be within walking distance and we will not be taking public transport or visiting museums

• Please note that although I have insurance in the studio (seguro Responsabilidad Civil) I will need you to sign an authorisation form for the excursions.

What is the cost & payment process?
